- The Land Use Ordinance to be re-written with two minor changes.
- The Recycling and Waste Haulers ordinances were reviewed with no action taken.

- The Village will look into participation in the Wisconsin Water Assistance Program, provided there are no strings attached which would add extra costs for the Village.
- The Feed My People Program will add the Village to its' planned stops this summer.
