## **PROPOSED Meeting Minutes for March 9, 2026 Village of Radisson Regular Board Meeting**

**CALLED TO ORDER:** President, Seth White, called the Village of Radisson regular board meeting to order at 5:00PM on Monday, March 9, 2026.

### **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE RECITED**

**Board Attendees:** President, Seth White, Trustee, Joanne Ferguson, and Trustee, Sue Spayer.

**Other Attendees:** Public Works, Robert Sampson and Leonard Thorson, and Clerk/Treasurer, Tera Rautio, and five (5) residents (Alisha Koach, Arlene Turner, Kim Cook, Andy Carli, and Becky Suzan).

S.White motioned to add a Resolution to new business regarding increases to pay discussed during closed session employee reviews, seconded by S.Spayer, motion carried.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** S.White motioned to approve the March 9, 2026 regular meeting agenda, seconded by J.Ferguson, motion carried.

**APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:** S.White motioned to approve the February 9, 2026 regular meeting minutes, seconded by S.Spayer, motion carried.

### **APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORTS:**

Village Treasurer Report (VTR): J.Ferguson motioned to approve VTR, seconded by S.Spayer, motion carried.

Water/Sewer Treasurer Report (W/STR): J.Ferguson motioned to approve W/STR, seconded by S.Spayer, motion carried.

Village Voucher Report (VVR): S.Spayer motioned to approve VVR, seconded by J.Ferguson, motion carried.

Water/Sewer Voucher Report (W/SVR): J.Ferguson motioned to approve W/SVR, seconded by S.Spayer, motion carried.

Public Works/Water & Sewer Update: Public works discussed their water regulation plan; goal to flush 300,000 gallons of water in 2026; will start with flushing 50 gallons; will flush tower and hydrants in a specific directional pattern; and will start chlorination in May. Public works to follow-up next meeting on reporting the estimated cost to repair pump #1 at Lift Station No. 3. R.Sampson stated they still have Well #2 shut off, 6 days so far, wondering if this pump is causing the bubbles in the water.

**AUDIENCE RECOGNITION:** A.Turner asked if the bubbly water is what is causing the cloudy water. Appears so per S.White, yet still being investigated as it appears air is getting pulled into the system. S.White asked public works to provide any updates to the cloudy, bubbly water at next meeting. Kim Cook advised Ogden Road appears to be eroding in a specific area. Public works will check out the road.

**OLD BUSINESS:** PSC Docket 4910-PFP-101 in progress – nothing discussed this meeting.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- a. S.White presented his Garbage Bag Price Reduction Review packet; evaluating a price reduction of \$4 per bag to \$3 per bag. Documentation shows even with reducing bag cost to \$3 and a 10% per year increase in removal costs, the Village wouldn't break even until approximately 2034. S.White motioned to approve the reduction in garbage bag costs to \$3, effective Wednesday, March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026, seconded by J.Ferguson, motion carried.
- b. Set date and time for Board of Review with Marv Nordquist. Board unable to decide on date and time. T.Rautio to follow up with Board on date and time and BOR training for S.Spayer.

- c. Village Board discussed and approved the Land-Use Permit request from Becky and Stacy Suzan for a 40'X8' addition to the front of their large pull shed building. S.White motioned to approve the permit, seconded by S.Spayer, motion carried.
- d. S.White discussed the new Resolution No. 2026-04-09, increasing Kate Hendricks hourly rate to \$13 and Tera Rautio's salary to \$2,250 per month; that the adjustments are within approved Village budget; and that the Clerk/Treasurer is authorized to update payroll accordingly. S.White motioned for approval of this Resolution, seconded by J.Ferguson, motion carried. S.White asked for a hand count vote approving Resolution No. 2026-04-09, all Village Board members raised their hands voting yes.

BOARD COMMENTS: None

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

S.White provided a high-level overview on the Winter School Referendum coming up on election day.

S.White discussed the 2029 State Road 27/70 project; and the option for the Village to do a facelift, i.e. sidewalks, street lights. S.White put a vote on our Facebook page regarding the facelift.

S.White announced the Village granted a provisional alcohol and tobacco license on March 4, 2026 to Muman Bros WI, LLC at Radisson gas station.

S.White announced the new Clerk/Treasurer in office hours, Mondays 10-6PM, Tuesdays 8-4PM, Wednesdays 10-2PM and Fridays 10-2PM.

S.White announced the next regular meeting will be on April 13, 2026 at 5:00PM.

ADJOURNED: S.White motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by J.Ferguson, motion carried, meeting adjourned at 5:51PM.
